ACA L1 Kayak Instructor Certification Workshop (L1 ICW)

Description of the ICW

There are numerous benefits to becoming certified as an ACA Instructor:

- Significant improvement in your own kayaking skills
- Learning how to teach others to kayak
- Instructor discounts from major manufacturers
- Insurance for courses that you teach

During 3 days of training, we will cover the following areas:

- **Stroke Improvement:** Learn how to paddle faster, and further, with less effort. In addition, by learning proper paddling techniques, you will decrease the chances of injury and sore joints (does your shoulder hurt after a day of paddling?)
- Safety and Rescues: Learn how to minimize the chances of a capsize ... and how to rescue yourself, and others, when not if a capsize occurs.
- **Teaching:** Learn how to teach the above skills to other kayakers. For those who are able to meet the criteria, you may be able to certify as an ACA L1 Kayak Instructor.

A significant amount of time is devoted to improvement of personal skills, so you should leave the ICW as a significantly improved paddler. Given the attention paid to personal improvement, this course is also an excellent choice for paddlers who want to improve their skills and are not interested in instructor certification.

You should be aware that participating in the workshop does *not* guarantee that you will be certified. There are specific ACA criteria and tasks that you need to satisfy. However, if you are willing to do some preparation, and if you are open to coaching in order to refine the necessary skills, you stand a very good chance of becoming certified. This class is open to all types of kayaks including sit on tops, sit ins, sea kayaks and recreational boats.



Instructor Trainer Background

His certifications include L3 Coastal Kayak Instructor Trainer, L4 Open Water Coastal Kayak Instructor, and L3 River Kayak Instructor.
